THE SQUARE, however, is banished from Spaceland when he expresses a desire to see the fourth dimension, and whatever lies beyond Naturally, the inhabitants of a world mitted to three dimensions carnot contemplate anything so rideculous. would cause others to doubt his sani-yare being banished from Spac-land, the square returns home and tres to enlighten his fellow men as to the existence of a third dimension. He is condemned for "pervering the minds of people by delisioners". He is considered hererodox if not downright treasonable, and is eventually licked up in a place set asside for function where he can do no harm to fundate unids of his innocent grandchildren. "Platland" is sturical, enlight-ening, refreshing, and stimulating to the imagination. I recommend it with-out reservation to ansene who likes to thank.
