warmth and concern I feel is commu-nicated through the phone to the cal-ter on the other end of the line. Many hours of intensive training are required before becoming a crisi-phone worker, including sessions on crisis courseling, courseling ethos, substance abuse, suicidology, first aid, overdosse aid, rational emotive herapy, sexuality awareness and re-ferral resources. I "rule played" with my fellow coun-selors under the supervision of profes-sionals, and I learned that I wasn't there to try and solve other people problems, but to listen and try to help each person work out his problems brough for himself. Persons experiencing many varied erists situations call Ruphe. Among them are a 14-year-old who is afraid

of being left out because he doesn't want to 'drop' with his friends, and a lonely woman whose children have grown up and left home. Others are a student worned that he may have flunked his biology final, a man whose alcohol use is interfering with his job, a scared guir who thinks she's pregnant. I could go on and on.

Persons calling are frightened, de-pressed, or lonely who need to know they can talk in confidence with some-body who cares.


