## Farmington School gets IRS exemption

The internal revenue service has issued a ruling recognizing the tax-exempt status of the Flight Plan School of Farmington that has announced a racially nondiscriminatory policy in admission of students to all activities of the private school.

The ruling has been issued under the statement of position announced by the IRS on July 10, 1970, concerning the tax exempt status of private schools, according to R.L. Plate, IRS district director of Michigan.

In that statement the IRS concluded that it could no longer legally justify recognizing exempt status to private schools that practice racial discrimination. Nor can it allow gifts to such schools to be treated as charitable deductions for income tax purposes.

The IRS position is applicable to all private schools throughout the United States.

Where a school has publicly announced a racially nondiscriminatory policy, Plate explained, for purposes of issuing a ruling the IRS will assume that such a policy has been adopted and will be maintained in good faith.

Plate stressed the IRS maintains a vigorous program of auditing tax exempt organizations. Examinations of private schools will take into account any complaints from the public or information from other sources that would indicate noncompliance with assurances made by the schools to the IRS.

If an examination indicates that a school has not administered its nondiscriminatory policy in good faith, the tax exempt status of the school will be challenged.

Should an existing ruling to a private school be revoked as a result of a challenge, Plate said, persons contributing to the school will be allowed to deduct contributions made before the date of the IRS notice of withdrawal of advance assurance of deductibility.
