'Inherit The Wind' next for the players

Hope and George Nahtoll team up again for the Farmington Players when they open the season with Jerome Lawrence and Robert E. Lee's "Inherit the Wind" set to run for three weekends in the players' barn. Nahtoll is producer and his wife director of the story which recounts the famous "monkey trial" which took place 50 years ago. The drama took place in the Rhea County courthouse in Dayton, Tenn. when two of the most powerful lawyers of the day collided in the interpretation of the Bible. William Jennings Bryant is played

by Matthew Harrison Brady, and the part of Clarence Darrow is taken by Henry Drummond. The play takes its name from the book of Proverbs: "He that troubleth his own house shall inherit the wind." Mrs. Nahtoll describes it as the depiction of "the right a person has to have a thought, and to express that thought, without going on trial for it." She added that she believes the issues of their conflict have acquired new dimensions and meaning for today's world.
