JACK D. LASLIE of Birmingham has been named vice president in charge of sales for Future Products Tool Corp.

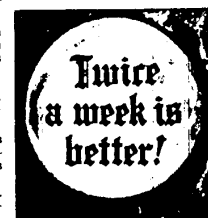
A graduate of Ball State University, he joined the firm in 1967 and has held the position of sales manager for the past five years.
