

Adrian president will talk Nov. 9

Dr. John H. Dawson, president of Adrian College, a liberal arts college, will speak in the First United Methodist Church of Farmington on Grand River at Warner Sunday, Nov. 9, at 10 a.m.

Dr. Dawson has been president of Adrian College since 1953 and has an extensive background of educational accomplishments. There's nothing unusual about a man going into a restaurant except when he enters through the restaurant's front wall and does it while he's still driving his car.

That's what happened at 9:30 a.m. Tuesday, Nov. 4, at Jakk's Restaurant and Chop House, 25234 Greenfield, a block north of Ten Mile Road.

Chuck Formosa, chef at Jakk's described the incident saying, "I was getting lunch prepared in the kitchen. I heard this loud rumble and a man ran into the kitchen and said, 'get out.' I thought a gas main had exploded."

Jim Hetu of Oak Park was standing in front of Jakk's when he saw Julius Louis Ascher of 15800 Providence, Southfield, drive his medium-sized sedan through the front wall of Jakk's.

While wandering through the wreckage that once was his dining room, Goldberg was still able to find humor in a phone call asking for lunchtime reservations.

WHEN ASKED HOW much he estimated the damage to the restaurant to be, Goldberg surveyed the wreckage, scratched his head, thought for a while and then answered, "About \$45,000."

A dazed Ascher was taken to Providence Hospital where he was pleased and went home.
