Auxiliary police increase request. made by Hills safety chief Holko

"The auxiliaries normally ride along and are observers only in residential districts." he said.

The auxiliaries, when called in for special details, are paid 839 an hour. They are used to supplement patrol units on holidaysand special occasions. They are also used to patrol subdivisions, making patrol cars /visible during the evening hours.


