

Concert marks 10 years for Farmington Musicale

"Let's Celebrate Together" is the theme for the evening as the Farmington Musicale marks its tenth anniversary with a concert of Christmas music in Antioch Lutheran Church Wednesday, Dec. 10 at 7 p.m. The church is located on the corner of Thirteenth Mile and Farmington Roads. Performing artists will be the Rev. Bertil Anderson, organist and pastor

at Antioch, and Francesco Di Biasi, trumpeter. Rev. Anderson had his master's degree in music and was working on his doctorate at the University of Minnesota enjoying a successful career as a musician, when he decided to make the ministry his life's work. Di Biasi is director of the Oakway Symphony Orchestra.

Rev. Anderson will perform "Chorale in A minor" by Frank and the "Prelude and Fugue in D Major" by Bach. Di Biasi will join him to perform a work for trumpet and organ. The Farmington Musicale Chorus, under the direction of Mrs. Bertil Anderson, will sing carols by Alfred Burt and Christmas music by Elbert and Bach, and it will accompany the organ in "Alleluia" from "For Us A Child Is Born" by Bach.

The Farmington Musicale will be given a Double Ribbon, a three star award, the highest award given to a senior club affiliated with the National Federation of Music Clubs.

The evening will be concluded with the singing of Christmas carols by the guests, led by Marie Walsh. Others for the occasion will be the Farmington Musicale past presidents.

Duns Scotus hosts 'Bach for a Buck'

Johann Sebastian Bach will star once again at the fifth annual Bach for a Buck Festival. Three repeat concerts are scheduled for 8:30 p.m. Dec. 26 and 27 and 4 p.m. Dec. 28. They will be performed in the Italian gothic chapel of Duns Scotus College, Nine Mile and Evergreen Roads, Southfield. Detroit Symphony bassist, Raymond Benner, artistic director and founder of Bach for a Buck, will preside over a week of Bach workshop sessions which culminate in the concerts. Benner brings together the Detroit area's finest young talent here for the holidays from the various music schools and conservatories. The group called the Duns Scotus Chamber Players will be joined by the Denby Festival Chorus, Gordon Nelson, director, in excerpts from the Christmas Oratorio. This will be the Denby Choir's first appearance at the Duns Scotus event. The all-Bach concerts, which play regularly to standing-room-only audiences, are sponsored by the Southfield Arts Council, the City of Southfield Park and Recreation Department and the Chamber Music Society of Detroit. Duns Scotus College is the sponsoring host.
