

Senior cab service extends its area

senior to the welfare of our senior citizens," said Deadman.

The council also approved use of the special cabs to persons designated as handicapped by a government agency, such as the Veterans Administration. These persons would have to be physically able to use a standard cab for transportation because the cabs aren't equipped for persons with special needs.

To beef-up the service, the city plans to dip into the community development funds, allocating \$2,000. The most recent survey was conducted among 21 persons using the service.

The complaint about tardiness seems to have cleared up since the last survey, according to Deadman.

"It would appear from those surveyed that the problem of promptness has been addressed by the cab company," said Deadman. "The majority of the 21 persons selected at random from those who use the cab service, don't perceive the delay in waiting as a problem."

THE SURVEY REVEALED the majority of persons have a 15 to 20 minute wait.

Of the 21 persons surveyed, each stated they had no permanent transportation available to them. Therefore without the senior special they were forced to rely on the availability of friends and relatives.

"They believe the cab service allows for greater mobility and freedom," he said.

Those surveyed were asked about

how often they used the service, about its promptness, driver courteousness, what other means of transportation they had available and the convenience of the service.

A communications problem indicated in the previous survey seemed to be eliminated, said Deadman.

We believe that the communication problem was solved by mailing out information to all senior citizens registered to vote in the city as well as having the mailer available at the city's general office and at the senior citizen social club.
