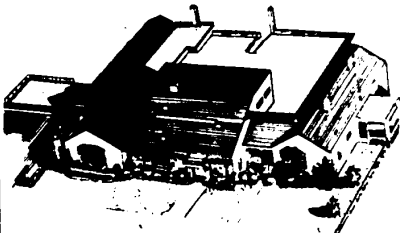

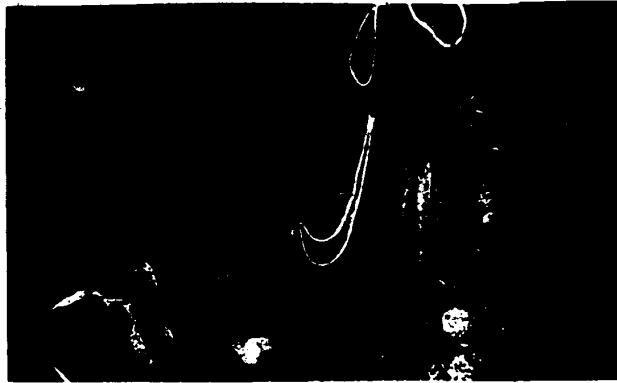

Students fight to save tree

to expand the library and industrial arts areas, says Keen.

When they realized that the tree would have to be removed from the courtyard to make way for the new annex, Keen thought something should be done. He felt it would be a shame to cut it down, so he asked the student council and Mark Gaudoin if they wanted to transplant the tree.

"The student council thought it was a good idea and were really excited," continues Keen. "The project will give the students something worthwhile to work on together and it should prove to be a really rewarding experience to save our tree."

SEVERAL WEEKS AGO, the school Beautification Committee, composed of Dunekel students, parents and teachers, began working on the project. At that time, the group set a goal of \$500 to transplant the tree to the front of the school building.

Mrs. Ann Rodwig, Mrs. Betty Frankel, Mrs. Ann Summerville and Larry Biehl, parents working on the committee, took an active role and began contacting nurseries to get estimates on the cost of transplanting the tree.

Keen says it will require outside specialized labor to transplant the tree and a crane will be needed to lift it out of the courtyard to a new location on the front lawn, where it will become part of a new Bicentennial area.

"In conjunction with the Bicentennial, we would like to transplant the tree to a new area in front of the school," says Keen. "We hope this area will be completed sometime this spring and it would have signs, a flower bed and feature our Douglas Fir as its showcase."
