

# Nathan Hale's dilemma the subject of musical



Nathan Hale's story is the subject of a musical drama being presented through Saturday at the Detroit Youththeatre in song and dance by the Maximillion players.

America's largest Bicentennial performing arts celebration for young people continues as the Detroit Institute of Arts YOUTHEATRE presents live on stage the dramatic musical play "One Life: The Dilemma of Nathan Hale" through Saturday at the Art Institute auditorium.

Weekday performances are scheduled at 10 a.m. and 1 p.m. and are open to the public grades four to eight. Tickets to the two "Something Every Saturday" performances at 11 a.m. and 2 p.m. Saturday are available for families and groups with youngsters ages eight and older (Children under 5 years old will not be admitted).

"One Life: The Dilemma of Nathan Hale" tells the story of Nathan Hale and the story of the revolt of the American Colonies, focusing on the personal side of the conflict amid the turbulence of historic events.

Nathan Hale's dilemma is that of a young man choosing between his career and his country's needs, between his sweetheart and his country's demands, between his life and his country's liberty.

The musical play by New York's

Maximillion Productions explains how Hale resolved his dilemma by enlisting in the Continental Army, his work as a spy behind enemy lines and his martyrdom.

I only regret that I have but one life to lose for my country," has echoed through history.

Saturday is also Girl Scout Salute Day at the Detroit YOUTHEATRE. The YOUTHEATRE will be saluting Michigan Girl Scout troops by featuring local Girl Scouts assisting the theatre staff and lobby displays in the Crystal Gallery of the theatre. The displays will focus on the Girl Scouts' achievements of the past year and the projects they have planned for the Bicentennial.

General Admission tickets are now on sale for all YOUTHEATRE attractions at the Art Institute Ticket Office at \$1.75. Special rates for groups of 10 or more are available as well.
