

North tankmen down Lathrup

North Farmington's depth was showing in the Raiders' 88-84 victory over Southfield-Lathrup in a non-league swimming meet last Thursday.

Coach Pete Biglin's Lathrup team led, 28-18, after the third event in the 200-yard individual medley. But North Farmington outscored the Chargers in the 50 freestyle and took first, second and fourth in diving to tie the meet.

The contest continued to be close. "The backstroke was a real turning point for us," said North Farmington coach Pat Duthie. "We outscored them, 13-3. It came down to the last 400-yard freestyle relay, which Lathrup won. We were leading, 82-76, going in. We took second and third and picked up six points."

Lathrup's Dave Smith won two events, setting a North pool record in the 100 butterfly (1:55.3) and besting

the 200 IM (2:10.6). He also swam on Lathrup's 200 medley relay, which was first in 1:48.5.

Bill Dunn also won two events for Lathrup. He topped the 50 free (1:23.6) and the 100 free (3:21.4), and then swam on the winning long relay (3:27.1).

North Farmington sophomore Clay Scowcroft continued his impressive swimming by winning the 500 free in 5:17.7 and taking second in the 200 free. Teammate Keith Dreyer won the 100 back in 1:01.1. The Raiders were impressive in diving with Bob Wetterholt winning with 191.15 points and Tim Kuhn taking second.

Earlier last week, North Farmington defeated city-rival Farmington High, 116-55, in another non-league. Scowcroft won two events, the 200 free (1:58.6) and the 500 free (5:22.5). Campbell was a double winner, taking the 200 IM (2:17.7) and the 100 breast (1:09.0).

Coach Jack Merritt's Farmington squad won just one event, the 400 freestyle relay. The team consists of Ken Outkowsky, Jeff Nonen, Mike Huff and Fred Beattie. Winning time was 4:04.9.
