

THOUGH HER CHRISTMAS cards are lovely, they are not Sr. Angeline's favorities nor her best sellers. The reason is that everybody has cards available at Christmas, but for ther holidays she has the market more to herael!

"We sell a great many Easter cards." she said, "because they are harder to find And New Year's cards are very popular, especially with the teaching nurs who like to use them to write thank you notes. Sr. Angeline also designs recovery, birthday, congratulary and other special occasion cards as well as sets of posters popular with the younger set. THE TIME IT TAKES to produce a design varies, she said, explaining that "it depends on whether I'm inspired."


