Baking for people with food allergies

When it's cold outside, you might enjoy being snug in a warm kitchen baking. However, it becomes a bit of a problem when someone in your family is allergic to wheat, eggs or milk. And some people must avoid gluten. Gluten is part of some flours, including wheat flour.

The U.S. Department of Agriculture has a new booklet of recipes to help solve this dilemma. For a copy of "Baking for People with Food Allergies" send 35 cents to Consumer Information Center, Dept. 78, Pueblo, Colorado 81009.

The publication includes the following tips:

SOME SUBSTITUTE flours that can be used in your recipes include barley, corn, potato, rice, rye, soy and tapioca. And, pastry can be made with crushed cereals.

Before you use a recipe without wheat, eggs or milk, you should understand that the end product won't always have the same taste, texture, appearance, and aroma as the ones

you're used to. This is because the ingredients left out are usually the ones that add shape. So recipes made without any wheat flour tend to become heavier and more crumbly. The same is true for baked items without eggs. When you shop for the ingredients in the recipe, be sure to read the labels on all of them, including the shortening and baking powder. Most baking powders contain cornstarch and some contain egg white. However, special baking powders are available that do not contain cornstarch or egg.

And, most margarines contain milk solids. But, you can buy milk free margarine, or use vegetable shortening if it contains only the fats you're not allergic to. Some vegetable shortenings list the vegetable fats and others do not. People who cannot use milk products have wondered about whipped toppings. But, whipped toppings may contain milk derivatives such as lactose or sodium caseinate.

Be sure to check all the labels carefully. And, if in doubt, don't use the product until you can get further information.

"Baking for People with Food Allergies" (35 cents) is one of over 250 selected Federal consumer publications listed in the Winter Consumer Information Index. 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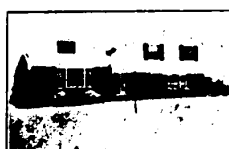
