# Prof. suggests national care

Reimbursement for "health con-servation" services ought to be part of national health insurance pro-grams, says a Michigan Stafe Univer-sity urban and metropolitan studies professor.

Patricia Barnes-McConnell, recently testifying before a U.S. House Sub-committee on Health, urged "a more realistic approach to improving the health status of the entire population in the face of escalating curative health costs."

She said community health con-servation would emphasize health edu-

cation and preventive measures. This might also include: involvement in local environmental or occupational health issues: efforts to change un-healthy but culturally supported life-styles; and health-related community development activities.


