Oranges have ancient value

In most American homes, Christmas would not seem like Christmas without oranges.
The orange, often referred to in Greek mythology and European fairy tales as “the golden apple,” is one of the oldest and most versatile fruits.
Everyone is familiar with its value as a food. The juice helps maintain alkaline reserve, is mildly laxative and is readily assimilated into organic tissue by even the weakest stomachs. In the time of Shakespeare, it was fashionable to carry pomanders on your person. These were oranges from which all the pulp had been scooped through a circular hole made in the top. Then, after the pulp had become dry, the fruit was filled with spices to make a sort of scent-box.
European folklore tells us that if a man desires the love of a particular maiden, he should take an orange and prick it all over with a needle, then sleep with it under his armpit. If the loved one eats the orange, then she will return his love.
MINORCAN MEN would sing on the holidays beneath balconies and grilled windows. After the seventh verse they would sing:
“Blessings on the one who walked this house about,
May the dwelling's owner hand a token out
Fruit or tart or cheesecake, we like anything.
Say not ‘no’ to us who stand with-out and sing.”
The petite host would then pass out oranges or orange wine with tiny honey cakes.
“Aphrodisiac Cookery” attributes the orange with the power to draw love and contains many recipes calling for the fruit or its juice.
When I was a child at home, both my Grandmas Patterson and Thornton used to make fairy butter for birthdays, holidays and company dinners. Perhaps you would like to try it.
FAIRY BUTTER
Take the yolks of two hard-boiled

eggs and beat them in a mortar with one tablespoon of orange juice and two teaspoons of powdered sugar. Work this to a fine paste, then mix it with an equal amount of fresh out of the churn. Force the mixture through a fine strainer onto a pretty little

plate. This is a pretty thing to set off the table (and perhaps inspire romance).
