The Kindle Fire™ HD/HDX app is available through the Kindle App Store. To install the Kindle Fire™ HD/HDX RBDigital app, please visit the Amazon App Store. Please also note, if the RBDigital app does not appear within the Amazon App Store on your device, then unfortunately your device is not compatible with the RBDigital app

Enable Your Kindle

- Go to the **Settings** menu by tapping the settings icon or swiping down from the top of the screen
- Choose **Security** (on some Kindles you will need to choose Device)
- Turn on the option **Allow Apps from Unknown Sources**
- You will get a warning message. Click **OK**.
- Go back to the **Home** screen

Download the RBDigital app

- From the Kindle home screen click Shop 
- Tap on apps 
- Tap the Search button and search for **RBDigital** 
- Tap on the RBDigital icon 
- Tap Get 
- Tap Download 
- The app will begin downloading. Once it has downloaded, tap **open** 

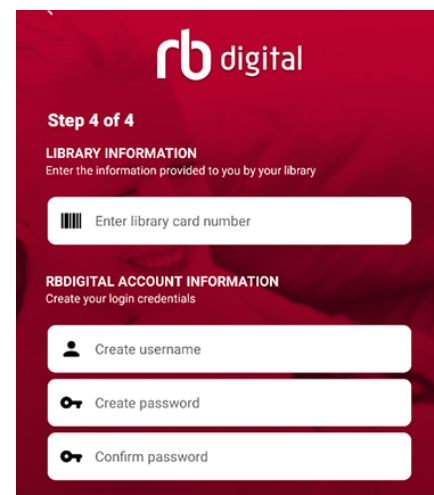

Create your new TLN RBDigital account

- Tap **Register Now**
- Search for and choose **Farmington Community Library**
- Type in your library card number, create a username and password, and enter your information (Figure A)

- Browse for magazines in-app by tapping  and tapping magazines
