Enable Your Kindle

Kindle Fire




- Go to the **settings menu** by tapping the settings icon or swiping down from the top of the screen
- Choose **Security** (on some Kindles you will need to choose Device)
- Turn on the option allow **Apps from Unknown Sources**
- You will get a warning message Click **Ok**
- Go back to the Home screen

Kindle HD

- Swipe down from the top of the screen. This pulls up the Quick Settings menu.
- Tap **More**
- Choose **Settings**, then **Device** (on some Kindles you will need to go to **Applications**)
- Tap on the option to turn on **Allow Installation of Applications from Unknown Sources**
- Go back to the Home screen

Download and install cloudLibrary

- On your Kindle Fire open the Silk browser and navigate to <http://www.yourcloudLibrary.com>
- Tap on the Kindle Fire icon: 
- Scroll down to tap **DOWNLOAD: Kindle Fire App** 
- Tap **Ok** to the message that pops up
- Tap **Download complete**
- When asked “Do you want to install this application?” select **Install** and then **Open**.
- If the app does not open tap on the Home icon and tap on the cloudLibrary™ icon to open the app. 
- Select your country and state from the drop down menus
