FUNDS

Library Endowment Fund

This is a self-renewing resource in which the principal of the gift is invested in perpetuity with a portion of the interest income used for a stated purpose.

Ernest Sauter Memorial Fund

Supports recreational reading materials featuring mystery and suspense fiction.

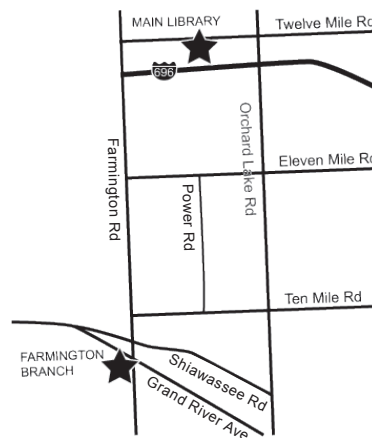
