Michael Feigelman of Southfield, 1974-75 president of the B'nai B'rith Hillel Foundation of Wayne State University, will be the guest speaker at the Women of Jewish National Fund Donor Tea at noon, Tuesday, Jan. 20, at Congregation Shaarey Zedek.

Feigelman is one of the leading young men in the metropolitan Detroit Jewish community. He has served as chairman of the student division of the Allied Jewish Campaign and was student representative on the Greater Detroit Jewish Welfare Board.

He is active in Congregation B'nai David and was a leader in B'nai Aliva, orthodox Jewish youth movement.

An ardent Zionist, Feigelman has visited Israel three times. He has been a delegate to the Student Mobilization for Israel and participated in the Student Leadership Mission to Israel after the Yom Kippur War.

He attended Hebrew University in Jerusalem and has written articles, and spoken before many organizations on behalf of Israel. He graduated with high honors from WSU and now attends his medical school.

The B'nai Shalom Singers will entertain at the tea. They have sung all over the world and their repertoire includes Israeli, Hebrew, Yiddish and English selections, all based on Biblical themes.
