

**Adams sinks Harrison**

**Andover swamps Falcons**

Southfield-Lathrup got its Metro Suburban Association swimming season off to a good start by beating Ulca Eisenhower, 106-66, last Thursday in Lathrup's pool.

Lathrup won six of the 11 events, but showed good depth. Dave Smith paced the winners by topping the 100-yard butterfly in :54.2, good for a pool and varsity record. Smith also swam on Lathrup's 200-yard medley relay, which won in 1:47.2.

"Smith is a good all-around athlete," said Lathrup coach Pete Biglin, whose team is 4-3 overall. "He's our captain, and he's doing a nice job leading the rest of the kids. I can always depend on him to get the others going."

Lathrup's Scott Mansfield set a school record in the 100-yard breaststroke with a 1:06.9 clocking. Teammate Bill Dunn won the 50 freestyle (1:23.5), and Charger Jim Barnhouse took the diving with 200.05 points.

Ulca Eisenhower had a pair of double winners in Tom Spaulding and Jim Vogle. Spaulding won the 200 free (1:53.2) and the 100 free (1:31.0). Vogle took the 200 Individual Medley (2:08.1) and the 500 free (5:12.0).

Earlier last week, Royal Oak Kimball defeated Lathrup, 97-75, in a non-league meet. Smith won the 200 IM (2:09.1) and the 100 fly (1:54.6). He also swam on Lathrup's winning (1:47.6) medley relay.

Thursday Farmington's lone winner was junior Jim Pogue, who took the 100 in :50.78.

Farmington coach Jack Merritt wasn't all that disappointed, despite the lopsided score.

"Most of the second stringers did a good job for us," said Merritt, whose squad is 5-3. "George Dorset had his best time in the IM—2:21.0. And Jeff Nosen had the best meet of anyone. He did a 2:09 in the 200 and a 6:02 in the 500."

Rochester Adams defeated Farmington Harrison, 119-53, in another non-league meet last Thursday. The loss left Harrison at 5-3 overall.

Coach Mark Holdridge's squad has been beset by injury and illness problems lately. Jeff Arnold has an eye inflammation, Jim Fisher has a sore throat, Chris Hoehner, Mark Person and Rob Wieland are down with the flu.

"We've had a disaster," admitted Holdridge. "Six of our best kids got sick the weekend of the Oakland County meet (Jan. 17). Somehow, just about everyone on the team got infected one way or another. We're just lucky we don't have another meet until next Thursday."

Adams won 10 of the 11 events. Harrison's Hoehner won the 100 fly in 58.6.

The winner of last Thursday's Southfield High-Birmingham Seaholm meet has yet to be determined. Seaholm swimmers didn't show up for the contest. Seaholm thought the meet was scheduled for Friday (Jan. 23).
