## Farmington GOP women prepare for campaigning

The Oakland County Council of Republican Women's Club, under the leadership of Bloomfield Hills' Lillian R. (Sharr) Dwyer, is beginning to prepare for a hectic presidential election year which includes a "wide-open" race for the U.S. Senate seat of retiring Philip Hart and a challenge to reverse the recent Democratic takeover of the Oakland County Board of Commissioners.

"We'll be active on all levels and expect to face the year with as many as 1,000 trained campaigners throughout the county," said Mrs. Dwyer.

The council represents six local units—in Farmington, Troy, Farmington, West Bloomfield, Portage, Bloomfield Hills and Royal Oak—and 800 members. But the election year membership drive is about to begin.

"We're definitely not a cookie baking group," said Mrs. Dwyer about the position of the women's club in the network of GOP organizations in the county.

"THE WOMEN'S CLUBS are the training grounds to launch women into the political arena," she said. "It's where we learn how to campaign and are encouraged to seek office."

"And the caliber of women who've gone on to successful candidacies—the State Rep. Ruth McNamara; Ruth Robertson, state chairman of the Michigan Civil Service Commission; District Judge Alice Gilbert and County Commissioners Lillian

Moffitt and Mary Maud Durbin—speak for our work."

"Of course we strongly disagree with Mrs. Durbin's decision to leave the Republican Party and join the Democrats after being elected by a strong Republican majority," said Mrs. Dwyer.

"You don't do things like that to your constituents," said Mrs. Margaret Thomas of Birmingham, retiring president of the county council of women's clubs.

Mrs. Thomas turned the leadership over to Mrs. Dwyer last week at an election meeting of the council. Both were interviewed earlier this week about the role of the women's groups in today's political scene.

**BOYS WOMEN** have been active in Republican politics for many years, on the state as well as local levels.

Mrs. Dwyer, the mother of three children and three stepchildren, got into politics in 1966 to campaign for Republican gubernatorial candidate Paul Bagwell.

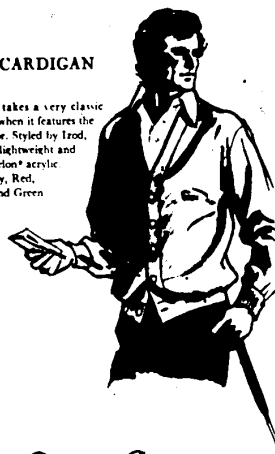
She helped organize the Birmingham-Troy Republican Women's Club—since divided into two clubs—and was its charter president. She is secretary of the Oakland County Republican Party and is ending her term as the second woman president of the county Lincoln Republican Club.

Mrs. Dwyer was a precinct delegate from 1972 and served as a delegate to most state conventions during that time. Also active in civic affairs, she is married to Joseph F. Dwyer.
