

## Communication career conference is planned

Seven groups of professional communicators are sponsoring Detroit's second annual "Transition" career conference on Saturday, Feb. 21, beginning at 8:30 a.m. in Marygrove College, McNichols (Six Mile) near the John Lodge freeway in Detroit.

Student and professional communicators will be able to attend four workshops dealing with various media careers. The luncheon keynote speaker will be columnist Bob Talbert.

A wrap-up session at 4 p.m. will provide informal round table discussions with the professionals who appeared at the 21 seminars held earlier in the day.

The advance registration fees, which are due Monday, Feb. 16, are \$10 for professionals and \$5 for students, and include lunch. "There will also be four workshops which deal with management and corporate communications. We've included sessions on job interviews and assertiveness, too."
