

# Concourse closes in on Over 30 crown

Only two games remain in the Southfield Over 30 Hockey League's regular season, but all the major titles—league champion, scoring leader and leading goalender—will all go for grabs.

League-leading Concourse-Carew moved a step closer to the title by beating Spartan Concrete, 4-1, on Feb. 19. Bob Goldman, Spartan's new goalie, played a strong game, but Concourse's Ray Tremblay scored two goals, while teammate Ed Dremann and Len Fitzpatrick each scored one.

Dremann's goal, his first of the season,

came on a penalty shot. He broke up a play at center ice, and then was trapped from behind on a breakaway. Chuck Drake scored Spartan's lone goal. The victory lifted Concourse to 14-2-3.

In another Over 30 game, second-place Northland Heating stayed within three points of Concourse's lead by beating Palfier Floral Home, 6-3. Ray Brunst scored two goals for the winners, now 13-4-4. (Other Northland goals came from Russ Stable, Don Brooks and Frank Gossens.)

Jim Bradley, Tom Jones and Ron Brewer scored for Sawyer Fuller.

Goldberg's tally leaves him seven points behind Concourse's Tremblay in the league scoring race.

Suburban Sports Center defeated Star Lincoln Mercury, 4-1. Howard Roff, Dennis Bagley, Ron Ellis and Harvey Gossens scored for Suburban, now in third place with a 9-4-2 record. Lynn Evans scored Star's goalie, Chuck Hoover. He'll have three goals behind Concourse's Ken Feldman in the race for the top goal.

Southfield Holiday Inn topped Arden's Firststone, 3-2. John Watterman, Ray Brandon and Bob Hawk tallied for Holiday Inn. Joe Kavalich and Stan Kassewicz scored Arden's goals.

The Over 30 season continues on Thursday (Feb. 26). Games include Star vs. Sawyer Fuller (7:30 p.m.); Northland Heating vs. Suburban Sports (8:30); Spartan Concrete vs. Holiday Inn (9:40); and Concourse vs. Arden's Firststone (10:30). All games will be played at Southfield's Civic Center Arena.

Russell stopped 30 shots against a miss at Lathrup blanked Taylor Kennedy, 5-0, last week in a nonleague game at Taylor Community Center rink.

"It was a well-deserved shutout for Rus-

Lathrup plays next on Thursday (Feb. 26) against city rival Southfield High. The Suburban Hockey League game begins at 7:30 p.m. in Southfield's Beechwoods Arena.
