White House Service Dec. 14

WASHINGTON — Congressman Jack McDonald, his wife, Joyce, and sons, Michael and David, will attend a White House worship service in Washington Sunday, Dec. 14, at the invitation of President Nixon.

McDonald, a Farmington Republican, was invited to the service in the East Room that the president sponsors each Sunday when he is in Washington.

The feature this week will be Christmas music sung by the New York Avenue Presbyterian Church Choir of Washington. McDonald himself is a Presbyterian.

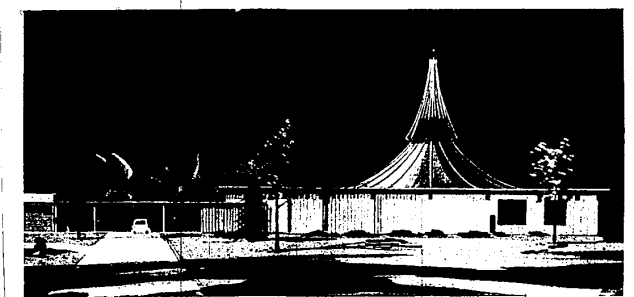
three units outlined in an ultimate plot plan developed in 1959 when Antioch Church was organized.

The first unit, built in 1959 and 1960, included a temporary worship center, minimum office space and Sunday school rooms.

THE NEW UNIT is dominated by a cruciform style sanctuary that seats 325 worshippers on three sides of a free-standing altar. There also is a center channel and room for additional seating of 90 persons.

Also a part of the new unit is a large narthex area, a three-room office complex and a church library.

Rev. Kallreider said the original plan was to construct a parish hall type of building as the third phase of the three-part plan. However, he added, the church leaders and congregation have come to feel recently that community facilities now available may make this construction unnecessary. There are no plans at this time for further building, he added.
