

Tree orders taken through April 23

Deadline date for ordering trees for Farmington Hills Beautification Commission's spring sale is Friday, April 23. Trees on sale are all offered at discount prices as a public service to residents.

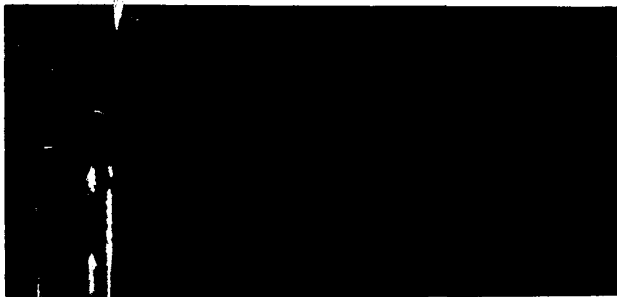
Kwanzan cherry trees are offered for \$9.50, flowering crabapples at \$7.50; Marshall's seedling ash and Thornless honey locust at \$12.50 each.

On sale for \$14.50 each are silver maples, mountain ash and Norway maples.

All trees are potted. Persons ordering five or more for delivery in the Farmington area will have them delivered at no charge. For persons ordering less than five, there is a charge of \$1.50 per tree for delivery.

Otherwise, trees may be picked up at Ecological Nursery, 28815 Farmington Road, Friday, April 30, and Saturday, May 1, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Pianists win Cranbrook awards

John Murphy, 26, and Richard A. Farner, 29, were awarded a first place tie in the Cranbrook Festival Piano Competition at Cranbrook House Saturday.

They will share the \$1,000 first prize and each will be awarded a master class with Gina Bachauer, the pianist who will be the featured guest artist at the eleventh annual baroque classical music festival at Christ Church Cranbrook May 6-9.

Susan Sulborski, 21, of St. Clair Shores, and a Michigan State University student studying with Dr. Joseph Evans, was awarded the \$500 second prize and a master class with Mme. Bachauer.

Joseph P. Palazzini, 22, of Mt. Clemens, and a student of Flavio Varani at Oakland University, Rochester, captured third place, which earned him \$250 and a master class with Mme. Bachauer.

Both Murphy and Farner attended the University of Michigan. Murphy began his doctorate with Gyorgy Sandor in 1972 and presently is a teaching assistant with him at U of M. Farner

has been studying with Charles R. Fisher at U of M since 1973.

The Cranbrook Festival Piano Competition was conceived to attract Michigan's top piano students — young men and women between 18 and 30 on the verge of becoming professional musicians. The festival was sponsored by the Cranbrook Music Guild, Inc. with the support of the Michigan Council for the Arts.

Judges this year were Dady Mehta, Flavio Varani, and Mrs. Teruko Yamasaki.

The competition is held in conjunction with Cranbrook Festival '76 which, this year, will present Gina Bachauer, the Toledo Symphony Orchestra, Serge Fournier, conductor, the Romero, Spain's first family of the classical guitar, the Wayne State University Chamber Choir, Harry Langford, Director; Emilian Allard, official carillonneur of the Dominion of Canada, and the Baldwin-Wallace Quintet.

The Detroit-area premiere of the Benjamin Britten arrangement of Henry Purcell's concert opera, "The Fairy Queen," will be one of the presentations.

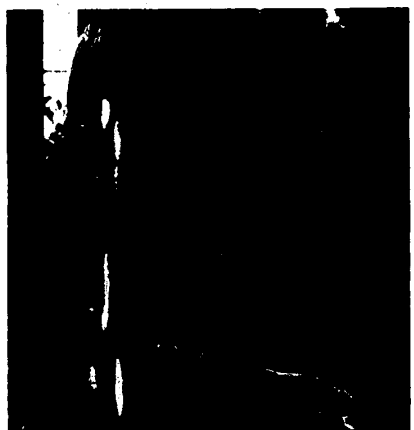
