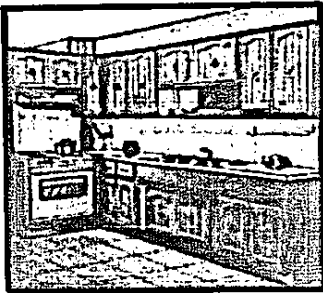

It's hard to decide among types of siding

An exterior home remodeling project often means new siding. Several types are available, each with its advantages and drawbacks.

Wood siding is the traditional choice. It is a good insulator, but it is subject to rot, cracking and termite damage, and must be painted regularly. It lasts a long time and is not easy to damage.

"Before you install wood siding, put an undercoat of paint on both sides of each piece," experts advise. "This helps to prevent moisture vapor in the house from getting into the siding and causing the outside paint to peel."

Pre-primed and even pre-finished hardwood siding is available, he notes.

Hardboard siding looks and acts much like wood siding, but it does not crack as wood sometimes does. It can

be purchased with a prime coat on both sides and a pre-finished vinyl coat on one side. This finish is nearly permanent and should not fade with time. Pre-finishing may make changing the color difficult, however.

Aluminum siding is popular because its baked-on vinyl or acrylic finish makes it practically maintenance-free. Some manufacturers guarantee their product will not fade for at least 35 years. Aluminum siding also does not rot, rust, peel, blister, corrode or burn.

"A drawback of aluminum siding is that it readily conducts heat," specialists say. "It also tends to be very noisy in a hard rain or hail, and it dents rather easily."

A polystyrene or fiber-board backing on aluminum siding reduces the

cause the reduced number of roots have to work harder to get it.

Not all sod is 100 per cent free of weed. There may be a few popping up here and there. The most practical way to eliminate them is with one of the spot weed killers.

Your new sod will also need fertiliz-

ing during the growing season. Put on an application during the warm weather--making sure to water it und still another in the fall.

Once the sod becomes established it will grow as fast as other grasses. For the first year, at least, set the mower so that it will cut at a height of 1 1/2 inches, no shorter.

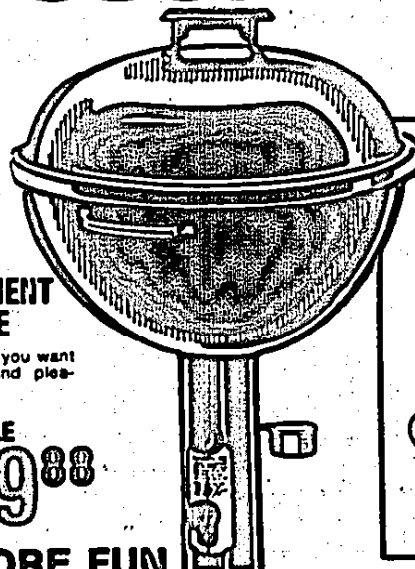
