CPR course starts in June

This is the lifesaving method of mouth-to-mouth resuscitation and external heart massage that forces the heart to pump blood.

The course will be held on two consecutive Wednesdays, June 9 and 10, in the Farmington Hills City Hall, room 200, 31500 Eleven Mile, 7:10 p.m. A certification card will be given to those who complete the course.

Participants must attend both sessions to be certified. The registration fee is \$2 which is waived for persons 60 and over.

low-garden-style apartments landscaped to give total residential appearance." J. Arthur Miller & Associates of Farmington Hills is the architect.

THE LOCATION is inappropriate, said Jordan, because the area is far from public transportation and hospital facilities. Moreover, dangerous.

"We think our site is the best location in town. It is convenient to shopping, to banking, to various meeting facilities, the Bot-

ford Hospital and the main transportation thoroughfare," he said.

"The site is within the mainstream life of the community, allowing existing interrelationships with the children and adults of the church, a mixing of generations."

Three of the four corners at the Eleven Mile and Middle Belt intersection are zoned for something other than single-family housing. The fourth corner is occupied by Our Lady of Mercy High School.

The southeast corner is occupied by a shopping center, while the northwest and southwest corners are zoned for office use.
