

Bonner, Hopkins win media 1sts

The Schoolcraft College student newspaper, The Campus Globe, has won three awards in the recent Michigan Collegiate Media Association contest held at Eastern Michigan University.

The Globe earned a second place in the best weekly newspaper category, and two staff members were awarded first place honors in individual competition.

The Globe's second place finish was "respectively rewarding for the staff," according to advisor Doug Johnson. "We competed with all the two-year and four-year colleges that publish a newspaper weekly."

First place went to Ferris State College, a four-year school.

Tom Bonner of Garden City won a first place award for his story and pictures on the Alaskan timber wolf. Fred Hopkins of Livonia won a first place award in feature photography for his picture of magicals which rest near the Schoolcraft Campus.

"CREDIT FOR the second place in the best newspaper category goes to the entire staff. However, our editor Greg Austin and chief copy reader Chris Buser, both of Northville, provided the leadership necessary to achieve this honor," Johnson explained.

Judge in this category was Will Snyder.

an editor for the Ypsilanti Press. His comments:

"This is another paper that is easy on the eye. With a couple of exceptions... the layout is very good. I liked some of the features such as the '30 day picture package.' It looks like the Globe really works hard here. It's sports coverage is well-balanced. It's good to see the girls get solid play on a page."

This was the first year the Globe had entered competition with other newspapers from colleges around the state.

THE GLOBE also recently received a second place rating in the annual critical rating service provided by the Columbia Scholastic Press Association (CSPA).

The ratings are based on standards set and administered by the CSPA, an organization of school newspapers and advisors based at Columbia University. Columbia is recognized as one of the top schools for journalism in the United States and is home base for the coveted Pulitzer Prize.

The Globe rating was based on a detailed evaluation of issues dating from January through December of 1975.

GOOD MARKS were given to editorials and advertising, headed this year by Keith Kube of Livonia.

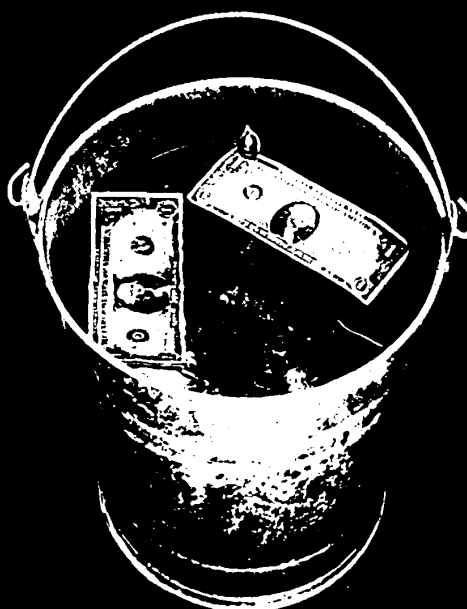
