The Council of the City of Farmington Hills met in regular session at City Hall on May 10, 1976. Mayor Oppenheimer called the meeting to order at 8:00 P.M. Council Members present were: Deacon, Dolan, Dudley, Lichtman, and McConnell. Council Member Smith was absent due to vacation. Others present were City Manager Majors, City Clerk Carra, and City Attorney Biboni.

Structure located at 2510 Middlefield Road declared dangerous and ordered demolished in accordance with Ordinance No. 28-B.

Public Hearing set for June 21, 1976 to vacate an alley in Section 33 between Alton and Pulaski Streets, south of Labor Drive granted unanimously.

Amendment to change the license fee in Solicitor's Ordinance from \$5.00 to \$25.00 enacted unanimously.

Jaycee's request for "Walk for House Bill" on Saturday, June 8, 1976 granted unanimously.

Resolution in opposition to House Bill No. 428 (Policemen's Bill of Rights) adopted unanimously.

Meeting adjourned at 10:07 P.M.
