Lathrup, Southfield lose meets

Speedy Northern nips Farmington

Speeds, Pontiac Northern won a close 64-62 meet from Farmington High in an Inter-Lakes League track showdown last Wednesday. Both teams had been undefeated in ILL meets going into that contest.

Living was the rule for the other four Southfield and Farmington high school track teams last week. Southfield High dropped both ends of a double dual to Farmington Seaboard 74-50 and Hazel Park 75-50 in addition to losing to Royal Oak 85-47.

Royal Oak handed better Southfield 84-60 in the Metro Suburban Association last Thursday. In the Northwest Suburban League, Redford Thurston defeated North Farmington 80-47 and Waterford Matt dropped Farmington 71-49 in the Western Sex League.

Farmington High can still win the league track title by finishing first in the 11.1 meet scheduled for May 25 at Milford Lakeland. But if Pontiac Northern's performance against Farmington last Wednesday is any indication, that'll be hard to do. Northern was one of the 16 events in which all three relays and all the sprints. In the Groves Lathrup met Groves Mike Agrelo defeated Sheldon Katz, 6-2, 7-5. In No. 1 singles, No. 4 singles was also a three-setter with Groves Dave Gishman trouncing Charlie Silver, 7-5, 6-4, 6-3. The Lathrup-Brother Rice meet was another story. The Chargers won every match except No. 1 singles, where Paul Hener beat Katz, 6-4, 6-1.

Lathrup is 14-3 overall. North Farmington's David Epstein defeated Thurston's Ron Prink in three sets, 6-1, 6-4, 7-4 in No. 1 singles. In No. 3 doubles, North's Greg Bosworth and Rick Karsub downed Mary Schmidt and Steve Lunk, 6-2, 6-4.

FARMINGTON HIGH now 5-7 overall and 5-5 in the Inter Lakes League, found Pontiac Northern to be a very pecking. Farmington's John Carlstrom, playing at No. 1 singles, beat Gordon Beckley, 7-5, 7-6. Farmington's No. 1 doubles team of David Krohn and Tom Ringwald beat Keith LaRue and Kris Berens, 6-1, 6-0.

No. 4 singles was a key match in Waterford's victory over Farmington. Jerry Bied defeated David Jansson in three sets, 6-4, 14-7, 5. Waterford also won No. 1 singles with Scott Tinsley taking Bert Hering, 7-5, 7-5.

The loss to Waterford didn't dampen the enthusiasm of Farmington coach Richard Burgess. "I'm super pleased with our kids," he said. "They've worked very hard, and they've improved tremendously. I couldn't be more pleased as a first-year coach."

the track it was a different story. The sprint (WM) killed us. We scored a total of one point in the 100, the 400, the 220 and the three relays.

Northern's Armer won the hurdles, taking the highs in 1:51 and the lows in 2:03. Teammate Malone won the 100-yard dash in 1:00.

FARMINGTON'S KEVIN Hansen won two events, the shot put (49-1) and the discus (128-1). Teammate Rick McKibbin won the high jump, 6-2. The loss left Farmington at 4-1 in the ILL and 5-3 over all.

Southfield High is 3-4 overall after losing the three meets last week. Southfield sophomore Ken Raby came through in the double dual with Seaboard and Hazel Park, winning the low hurdles (21-2) and the high hurdles (15-4). Southfield's 800 relay team, Ken Nien, Mitch Moore, Jeff Selzer and Stuart Brzozski, won in 3:45. Miles added a first in the 100 with a 1:07 clock time.

Lathrup is winless in four Metro Suburban Association outings, including the Don dem meet. Lathrup senior Brian Gidd had a good night in the sprints, tying his own varsity record of 10-1 in the 100 and

setting a varsity record of 22.5 in the 220. Lathrup's Gary Hawthorne won the 400 yard at 5:10, and teammate Tony Peron won the long jump at 18-9. The Chargers also won the pole vault and the 440. Scott Greengren won the vault with a 12-0 effort, and Mike Driscoll won the 400 with a 5:18 clocking.

Dando's Doug Verier took the high bar, 18-0, and the low hurdles (21-2). Thurston's victory over North Farmington left coach Ron Holland's Raiders with a 1-3 Northwest Suburban League mark and a 2-4 overall record.

North's Paul Ricci won two individual events, the 100 in 1:03 and the 220 in 22-8, and also ran on the Raiders' 400 relay, which won in 4:01. North's Bob Hering won the low hurdles in 3:06 and teammate Bob Reed won the high jump at 5-4.

Coch Tom Shula's Harrison team is 5-5 overall and 14-4 in the Western Sex League after losing to Met.

Harrison's Mike Bowden won the discus with a 127-0 throw, and ran on the Hawks' 400 relay, which won in 4:47. Other Harrison first place: Greg White in the long jump (20-1), John Hileman in the 400 (54-9), Mark Evans in the mile run (4:53), and Adam Weiner in the two-mile run (10:23).

In the 100 Harrison's Tom Reynolds edged second at 10-5, marking the first time this season that he's lost that event in a dual meet.

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
