

# 6 to attend LWV meeting

Six delegates from the West Bloomfield-Farmington Area League of Women Voters (LWV) will attend the 1977 Michigan State LWV Convention Friday-Sunday in Grand Rapids.

Among those scheduled to attend are Mary Lazeraton, newly elected president from Farmington, Ann Beuerle and Jo Roberts.

The purpose of this biennial meeting is to deal with budget, by-laws, adopt state programs and elect officers and directors.

The convention banquet on Friday evening will feature State Rep. William Ryan of Detroit anyzzzydeesidussuncs cities / urban crisis with a panel of league members. Former speaker of the house, Ryan is chairman of the House Urban Affairs Committee and

sponsor of a number of bills dealing with urban problems.

Two bus tours have been arranged. The first will visit alternative education facilities in the Grand Rapids Public Schools. Staff members will be available to answer questions.

The second is a housing tour covering neighborhoods chosen as targets for community development money. Also included will be Heritage Hill, the largest historic preservation district of its kind in the country.

There are 4,000 league members in the state, and 45 area leagues will be represented at this meeting. The budget to be adopted is expected to be \$73,000.

The public is welcome to attend the convention as observers.

## LWV to talk about energy

Energy will be the topic when the West Bloomfield-Farmington Area League of Women Voters hold its regular monthly general meeting at 9:30 a.m. Wednesday, May 25, at Farmington Community Library.

The library is at 32737 W. Twelve Mile in Farmington Hills.

The meeting will begin with a movie on alternative energy sources followed by presentations by member of the LWV energy committee Nancy Ohl, Ann Grant, Mrs. Beuerle, Jo Ann Roberts and Anne Dziuba will focus on the topics of coal, petroleum, solar power, nuclear energy, state and national energy programs and energy conservation.

Mrs. Dziuba, energy committee chairperson, will give a critique of President Jimmy Carter's energy program and talk about Michigan's program.

The local meeting is part of a nationwide study by the national LWV who are presently undertaking a two-year probe into critical energy issues in order to reach a stand by 1978.
