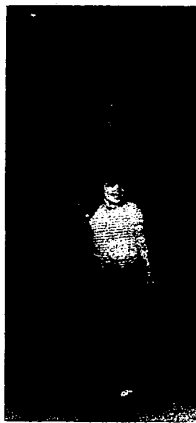


## On a clear day. . .

## Detroit woman sues cop

A Detroit woman is suing Southfield police officer for negligence and reckless driving, claiming she was seriously injured last March when the patrolman's car struck her's during a high-speed police chase.

Caroline Hairston, 29, has named Ptl. Walter Huffard and City of Southfield as co-defendants in a lawsuit filed in Wayne County Circuit Court June 10. Ms. Hairston, who is demanding a jury trial, is seeking \$10,000 in damages.

At about 7:40 a.m. March 1, according to the lawsuit, Ms. Hairston was traveling westbound on Seven Mile and Asbury Park in Detroit when she was involved in a collision between vehicles driven by Huffard and Roger Parker, a burglary suspect being chased by Southfield police officers. As a result of the accident, Ms. Hairston contended, her car was struck and collided with another auto going eastbound on Seven Mile. Because of Huffard's negligence, the lawsuit claims, Ms. Hairston was severely injured and her car was extensively damaged.

**THE CHASE** from Southfield to Detroit, at speeds reaching 90 m.p.h., according to a police spokesman, stemmed from a 7:15 a.m. March 1 burglary at Kelley Services Inc. on Northland Drive in Southfield.

Parker, one of two suspects in the incident, was injured in the three-car accident during the chase, held under police guard at Providence Hospital and was later charged with larceny, receiving stolen property over \$100 and felonious driving.

Parker and Huffard, according to the lawsuit, were speeding south on Asbury Park at Seven Mile. The chase began at Northland Drive and Eight Mile in Southfield and continued for about a mile and a half through residential streets before the collision, the lawsuit states.

The accident, according to the lawsuit, was caused by Huffard's negligence in instituting the high speed chase through residential neighborhoods and driving at speeds from 75 to 90 m.p.h. in a 25 m.p.h. zone.

The police officer, the suit alleges, failed to use flashers and sirens required of authorized emergency vehicles and disregarded the safety of others on the highway, creating a dangerous traffic situation.

"CITY OF Southfield violated its duty to advance reasonable rules and regulations governing high speed chases," the lawsuit alleges. "The city failed to prohibit the chase through a residential neighborhood which created a hazard without just provocation."

Ms. Hairston was taken to Providence Hospital with head, back and internal injuries as the result of the accident, the lawsuit claims. The suit alleges that Ms. Hairston's injuries are permanent and that she has been unable to work.

According to the Southfield police report of the incident, police spotted Parker and another suspect, Levester Hathorn, 24, speeding from the parking lot of Kelley Services Inc. after the burglary was reported.

During the chase, the police report states, the two burglary suspects ran a red light at Asbury Park and Seven Mile, striking two cars. A family of three from Highland Park, including a four-month-old baby, were occupants of one car involved in the collision. They were taken to the hospital and released, according to Southfield police. Ms. Hairston was listed in serious condition in the hospital, police said.

After arresting the suspects, according to a Southfield police spokesman, police officers had to use guns to protect the prisoners from a crowd of angry bystanders in the Detroit neighborhood. Residents were enraged mainly because of the injury of the child, police said.
