The accident, according to the lawsuit, was caused by Hufferd's negligence in instituting the high speed chase through residential neighborhoods and driving at speed from 75 to 90 m.p.h. in a 25 m.p.h. zone.

The police officer, the suit alleges, failed to use flashers and sirrens required of authorized emergency vehicles and disregarded the safety of others on the highway, creating a dangerous traffic situation.

"CITY OF Southfield violated its duty to advance reasonable rules and regulations governing high speed chases," the lawsuit alleges. "The city leaded to prohibit the chase through a residential neighborhood which created a hazard without just provocation."


