Howe's legend lives

When Gordie Howe played for the Detroit Red Wings there was a crowd wherever he went—gawking and asking for autographs.

The crowds aren't as large now, but they're still there. People flocked to see the hockey legend at his own golf tournament Monday at Southfield's Plum Hollow Golf Club.

The gallery was sparse throughout the morning, but when Howe teed off at 1 p.m., a large gallery was gathered and waiting to see the superstar.

When Howe's name was announced the crowd cheered. After his first shot the cheers grew louder and louder, just like the gallery that followed Howe around the course nine years ago when the tournament was initiated.

Howe simply turned and said, "forever's 1 year," when he was asked how long the tournament will continue, even though he'll be in New England next year.

Howe will be 50 next March, and he says he still is unsure about playing next year. "I'll try, but I don't know."

The hockey legend proved that his talent doesn't stop at hockey as he fired a 70, seven over par, which is considered a good round of golf at Plum Hollow.

THE TEAM WINNERS were determined by the best shot of the foursome at each hole. Each foursome was made up of one celebrity and three club members.

The tournament finished in a tie between two foursomes with a score of 57 for the 18 hole course. One foursome was headed by Tiger Mickey Stanley and club members Skip Speersneider, Jim Fulton and Jack Dekker. The other foursome was led by Budd Lynch, former voice of the Red Wings and now the head of the Wings public relations, and club members Ray Boes, Glenn Hayes and Gary Batherson.

The celebrities roamed the course signing autographs and making conversation with anyone who wanted to talk. Sonny Elliot, WJW-TV's weatherman was in top form as he joked around with the crowd and demanded a cheer after the first shot by WXYZ-TV's anchorman, Bill Bonds.

In all, everyone had a good time. For some people who turned out, it was a chance to see some of the past greats. But most of all it was a chance to see Gordie Howe, the greatest of greats.
