Once the sun begins to shine the restaurants do a booming business in carryout orders as the working force heads for the outdoors on their lunch hour.


Eating isn't the only pastime. Basebell, golf and fishing are also popular.

We also found girl watchers, but that's an activity not strictly confined to the parks during lunchtime.


The pictures, which were all taken in area parks over a two week period, speak for themselves.
