BEFORE OPTIONS are even discussed. Linden gives private consultations, without charge, to learn the history of the client and very often, in turn, works with a doctor, if there is a chance of a skin problem to be considered. Price is always based according to need.

"Our biggest selling point is the service we have to offer," Cussons

said. "Because we make everything here, no one has to wait six or eight weeks while we send the hair unit back to the factory. If a repair must be done, we can do it immediately.

"If we have to order something special, it might be three or four days, at a need for hair".
