Physician faces second lawsuit

A second lawsuit has been filed against Providence Hospital's chief of obstetrics and gynecology after his zealous last month of charges of second-degree criminal sexual conduct against a West Bloomfield woman.

Dr. Donald Krone did not deny charges that he entered the Porvin home at 4 a.m. Oct. 1 and attacked Mrs. Porvin.

Library announces summer programs

Open programs, including a pre-school nature walk, a talent show for elementary schoolers and an evening movie series, have been announced by the Farmington Community Library.

He was found not guilty because Judge William Beer questioned Krohn's intent because of intoxication, according to a spokesman for the county prosecutor's office.

Two events are scheduled for preschoolers this summer. One is the nature walk, a parent-child activity, which will take place at Oakland Community College's nature trail. Participants are asked to meet at Building A of OCC on July 21 from 2:30 p.m. (Farmington Branch) or on July 19 from 10:30-11 a.m. (Farmington Hills Branch).

In addition to a \$1.1 million civil suit filed recently by the woman, Ann Mae Porvin, and her husband Sanford, Krohn is being sued for \$70,000 by the Porvins' neighbors, Sylvia and Robert Penfil. Their suit was filed Wednesday.

The second event is a theatrical experience, in which young adult volunteers will present a play from 2:30 p.m. on Aug. 4 at the Farmington Branch and from 10:30-11 a.m. on Aug. 2 at Farmington Hills.

The Penfils charge that Krohn assaulted them when they came to Mrs. Porvin's aid.

Open programs for elementary school children are abundant, including a talent show, a nature walk and some puppetry.

According to Arthur Weiss, who is representing the couples, Mrs. Porvin and the Penfils are charging Krohn with assault and battery. Porvin is claiming loss of consortium. No trial dates have been set. Krohn still faces criminal charges of drunken driving and failing to stop for a police officer stemming from the incident.

DR. KROHN remains as Providence Hospital's chief of obstetrics and gynecology after a meeting of the Southfield hospital's board of directors last week.

The Farmington talent show auditions have already taken place, with the show scheduled for July 19 from 10:30-11:30 a.m., but the auditions for the Farmington Hills show are today at 2 p.m., so if you can make both the rehearsals on July 30 at 2 p.m., the show itself on July 21 from 2:30 p.m., the author of the library would like to see you.
