

# Solar hair? It's warm

"Solar Hair," designed by the National Hairdressers and Cosmetologists Association, is fashion's fall-winter approach to hairdressing, reports Roger Orr, director of Bonwit Teller's Michel Kazal Salon in Troy.

Solar Hair, defined, is warmer hair. Warmer because hair is longer, substantially longer. You'll be told to "let it grow" at least long enough to keep your ears and neck warm this winter.

Warmer because it is softer, curlier and more vibrant. Warmer because, as announced jubilantly by Roger's blonde wife, Sharon, who manages his salon, "blondes are back." Fall-winter hair colors are in the blonde-brown tones.

Softer, warmer hair colors reflect the pale, primary color palette of fall clothes. Last year's bright clothes put blonde hair in the pale and made the brunette woman "leader of the fashion-pack."

Solar hair has lots of volume, but not the "teased-bubble" look. Instead, the fullness stems from a smooth crown and is achieved with curls and volume-producing perms.

BOTH HAIR COLORING and curling have become an art whose purpose is to create a natural looking balance for the fuller look in clothing. Hair lengths vary from just below the shoulder to ear-length.

Growing hair longer takes some patience but once you're through the awkward stage of straggled-looking ends, you'll be able to resist

saying "cut it all off."

Straggled ends can be managed by lightly curling them in with more orderly lengths of hair and they will soon be unnoticeable.

Your hair is constantly growing and replacing itself. The hair at your scalp grows at a rate of about five inches per year during its life period, which is about two to five years. After that period, the root dies, the hair falls out and is replaced by another, younger root and hair shaft.

The natural color of your hair is determined by the pigment containing cells in the hair shaft. They determine whether you are a blonde, red-head or brunette. If the pigment is inadequate, the hair will appear silvery or gray.

IT IS NICE to know that what is fashionable is what looks natural today. But this does not mean that you must stay with your nature-endowed hair coloring, particularly if your hair color is dull and lifeless looking.

The Solar Hair is sun-touched, looking as though you carry sunlight with you. This is accomplished through highlighting individual hairs. Sun brilliance for hair may also be achieved through henna packs which will impart red rays to the hair or even otherwise mousey brown hair with natural henna highlights.

Other natural products, such as camomile teas and the ever-popular lemon juice have found favor with many hairdressers. But remember even though blondes are back, peroxide is not. Un-natural looking, bleached blonde hair is still out.

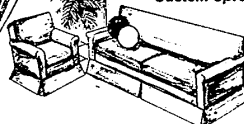
