

# Tennis, Crumpets to aid hospital

More than 3,100 Oakland County residents are being invited to a "love" match.

They are tennis players of all levels of ability who participated in previous "Tennis and Crumpets" mixed-doubles tournaments, fund-raising benefits for the Children's Hospital of Michigan.

The annual events have been held since 1967.

Mrs. William P. Benton, honorary chairman for this year's Oakland County tournaments, said invitations to the Sept. 10-11 round-robin competition are in the mail, with about 1,800 men and women 18 and over expected to enter.

There will be four levels of competition in the tournament—Open (One professional or college team member and one amateur, or two amateurs); Class A (advanced); Class B (intermediate); and Class C (novice or beginner).

Mrs. Benton said players wishing to enter the tournament should provide their own partners. If possible, and send the \$10 per-person entry fee by the Aug. 31 deadline to Tennis and Crumpets, Mrs. Edwin Spence, Jr., 612 Pilgrim, Birmingham, Mich.

4800. The \$10 fee includes tennis balls and lunch.

The action in all four classes will take place at 160 public and private county courts, with 160 volunteer hostesses on hand to organize the competition, help serve lunch and keep and report scores.

Tickets also have gone on sale at \$5 per person for the finals at the Franklin Racquet Club in Southfield on Saturday, Sept. 24 with international star Rod Laver on hand to present trophies to winners, offer tips on doubles play and take on several auction high-bidders in a "Win a point from Rod Laver" competition.

Tennis and Crumpets has donated more than \$300,000 to Children's Hospital since its inception ten years ago.

This year, Oakland County's goal is \$28,000 including payment of the four of five installments on the Cardiology Suite, with remaining funds pledged to the hospital's Poison Control Center. The center provides telephone emergency poison information to parents or baby sitters and the medical community.

The fashion revue will feature a cast of 43 students from the metro area. Oversized sweaters, matchmates, winter coats and accessories, and romantic dresses are included in the show.

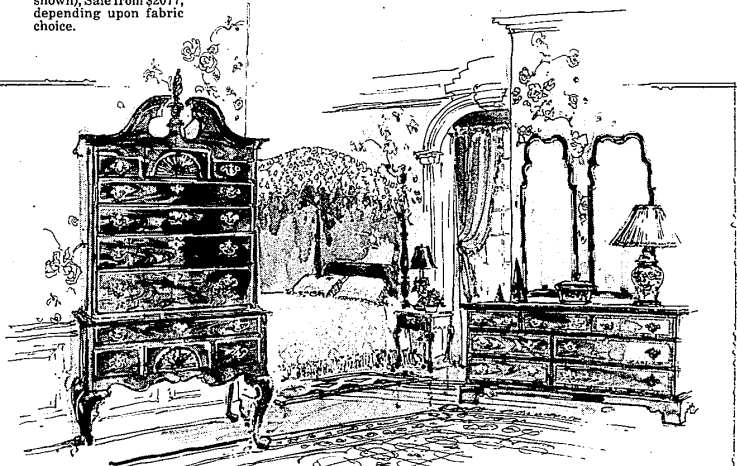
