Cedar Point Hosts Craft Festival

More than 50 artists and craftsmen will demonstrate their myriad skills, ranging from glass blowing to quilting, at Cedar Point June 14-29, during the Sandusky, O., resort's first Craft Festival.

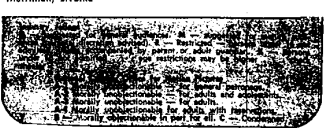
The festival will be staged in the new \$16,000 town hall building at Frontier Town. To help house the booths of the unexpectedly large number of exhibitors, a 50-by-70-foot tent will be set up nearby. There will be no admission charge for park patrons.

The Craft Festival is keeping with the policy of providing entertainment for all ages that has made Cedar Point the largest entertainment complex east of the Rockies, said George A. Roose, the resort's president.

Oakland Sets Tour Schedules

The Studio Company of the Oakland University has selected the plays that it will tour to high schools, clubs and churches throughout southeastern Michigan during the 1969-70 academic year.

Officials of interested sponsoring organizations and schools are encouraged to select one or more of the following plays before the close of the current school year since all reservations are confirmed on a first-come-first-served basis. Matinee and evening performances are available for each production.

THE FIRST PLAY, "Under Milk Wood," by Dylan Thomas, is a poignant portrait of people in a Welsh village told with humor and poetic beauty (Nov. 10 through Nov. 20). The second offering will be a triple-bill of one act plays by Thornton Wilder, Eugene Ionesco and Harold Pinter. These three internationally known playwrights represent the best of 20th century drama (Dec. 8 through Dec. 19).

The third production will be William Shakespeare's "Twelfth Night," one of the Bard's most delightful comedies (Feb. 9 through Feb. 20).

Shakespeare's romantic comedy, "As You Like It," will be the fourth play (March 9 through March 27). The final play of the season (May 4 through May 25) will be a Restoration Comedy.

These plays, which were selected with the cooperation of area high school teachers, will also be performed for four evenings each at Oakland University's Meadow Brook Theatre.

THE ACADEMY OF DRAMATIC ART will provide study guides and programs for each Studio Company play which will be produced with sets, costumes and props. The sponsors are asked to provide an adequate stage, minimal lighting and some stage hand assistance.

Organizations and schools interested in having a Studio Company play produced on their own stages are encouraged to make the event a fundraising project, keeping the proceeds after the initial flat rate charge is met.

Motel, trip on the Soo Locks and Soo Train, Tahquamenon Falls State Park, Pictured Rocks cruise, Keweenaw Park resort, Copper Harbor, Pictured Rocks National Lakes and the Clouds, and Kitchi-Uki-pi Indian Springs. Tour price per person including two lunches, double occupancy is \$191, single \$218.
