

Music-lunch starts Friday

The first in a series of 1977-78 musical luncheons sponsored by the West Bloomfield Symphony Women's Association will be held at 10:30 a.m. Friday at the home of JoAnn Von Steeg.

The donation musicale will feature flutist Susan Ivers Barna playing selections by Gosses, Debussy and Damase, and pianist Thomas Barna playing Schumann's "Blumenstuck," opus 19.

Ms. Barna, a member of the Pastiche Wind Quintet and former member of the Detroit Symphony Youth Orchestra, has performed at the "Workshop in the Woods" at Duns Scotus College in Southfield and has appeared as a soloist in the "Bach at Duns Scotus" Christmas concert.

She is a member of the Windsor Symphony Orchestra and has studied the past six years with Clement Barone of the Detroit Symphony Orchestra.

Thomas Barna is a graduate of Wayne State University and holds a degree in piano. Formerly a student of Bernard Katz, Barna has studied for the past eight years with Boris Maximovich. He manages the Pastiche Wind Quintet, teaches piano and is an accompanist. He is also a co-founder and president of the Kolego Concert Series.

Additional musicales are scheduled for Oct. 5 and 25.

Detroit sets free exhibits

Rare puppets in performance and on display highlight the Detroit Institute of Arts' portion of the seventh annual Cultural Center Open House from 7-10 p.m. Wednesday.

Cultural Center visitors will be welcomed with the music of the New McKinney Cotton Pickers, which will set up its bandstand in the middle of Woodward Avenue, closed between Farmworth and Kirby for the evening.

Art Institute attractions include Mel Biske, impresario of Chicago's Melkin Puppets, performing with historic puppets from the museum's permanent collection. Performances will be held every half hour beginning at 7:30 p.m. in the Lecture-Recital Hall.

"World on a String," an exhibit of 50 marionettes, hand puppets and giant figures, will have its premiere at the open house. The display will continue through Oct. 16.

Pianist Bernie Katz and soprano Suzanne LaCroix will perform baroque melodies to show tunes and current hits cabaret-style in Kresge Court. Shows will be every half hour beginning at 7:30 p.m.

GALLERY TALKS throughout the evening by staff members and volunteers will introduce recently acquired paintings and sculpture. Visitors will see modern American realism in Andrew Wyeth's painting "Sea Breeze," African wood sculpture "Nkonde Nail Figure," Fra Angelico's "The Annunciation," Perugino's "Madonna and Child," Pierre Renoir's bronze "Venus Victrix" and Frederic Church's "Cotopaxi" inspired by the Ecuadorian volcano.

All events are free as the Art Institute celebrates the opening of its fall season and its return to a six-day week with regular hours from 9:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Tuesday through Sunday.

In addition to the events at the Art Institute, the Detroit Public Library will offer a mixed media show with music illustrated by Richard Vernick's photo-paintings, treasures from private book collectors, special exhibits and Detroit women writers to discuss and autograph their books.

The Detroit Historical Museum will present exhibitions of coin-operated amusements, Packard cars, Detroit's salt mines and other displays.



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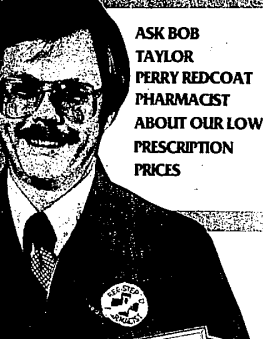
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
