Dial 'Hot Lines' For Campsites

LANSING From June 16 through Labor Day, latest information on campsite vacancies at state parks in Michigan will be available through two "hot line" outlets of the Department of

Natural Resources: U. Detroit and Reconnment, at the public recreation areas themselves, and at Tourist Information Centers of the State Highway Department.

Listings of available campsites throughout Michigan's entire state park system will be as close as the nearest telephones for recreationists who dial the DNR's Detroit Information Office any weekday between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m.
