

Annual walkalong scheduled for Oct. 23

Focus:HOPE has announced that its eighth annual brotherhood celebration will take place Saturday, Oct. 23.

Called the Focus:HOPE walkalong, the event brings together people from the entire metropolitan Detroit area. At four different starting points, they gather to walk eight miles toward a common destination, the Michigan State Fairgrounds.

Their four routes are: north on Woodward from Grand Circus Park; south on Woodward from Shain Park in Hamtramck; east on Eight Mile from Telegraph in Southfield; and west on Eight Mile from Schoenherr.

The walkalong theme "Let's Get Together" recalls those of previous Focus:HOPE festivals in downtown Detroit on the Kern block and the Detroit riverfront. "The walkalong is really an experience in brotherhood," Director Fr. William Cunningham said.

Focus:HOPE is people who believe in the future—a future for every child, a future free from racism, fear and hatred. We are calling on people from city and suburb to give their ideals a practical expression."

A concluding rally at the fairgrounds features speeches, entertainment by some of Detroit's outstanding musical artists and a ceremony renewing the walkers' dedication to interracial tolerance and understanding.

Over 10,000 people participated in last year's walkalong.

Established in 1968, Focus:HOPE is a civil and human rights organization with black and white volunteers throughout metropolitan Detroit. Current major projects include a supplemental feeding program for 35,000 undernourished mothers, infants and preschool children (the nation's largest), and an education program to ease tensions, improve racial relations and increase academic achievement at six recently desegregated high schools in Detroit.

This education program has just recently been expanded to include high schools in the city of Southfield. Other Focus:HOPE projects address stable residential integration and equal employment opportunities.

Donations from those who sponsor the walks are used to finance these year-round activities. All contributions to Focus:HOPE are tax-deductible.




