Local Wayne State classes begin soon

Southfield will be the site of several classes offered by Wayne State University this winter. The classes begin in early January. Final registration must be completed no later than Jan. 25.

WSU's College of Lifelong Learning is offering the courses, both credit and non-credit, in more than 80 locations in southeastern Michigan, and on television and radio.

All university extension credit courses offered through the College of Lifelong Learning are open to qualified students. Those students who have been admitted to WSU for a program of study and are in good standing with the university will have the "course credits and grades recorded on their transcripts. Those who have not been fully admitted to a degree program will be registered with "limited status".

Students may contact the Southfield office for further academic information or for guidance and counseling. The Student Services Office in Southfield is at 25610 Eleven Mile. The telephone number is 352-2104.

Courses are offered at the Southfield office and in Birmingham, Dearborn, Detroit, Garden City, Grosse Pointe Farms, Monroe, Mount Clemens, Oak Park, Royal Oak, St. Clair Shores,

Troy, Warren and Wayne. All registrations, requests for course schedules and counseling, are handled by the Southfield office. The counseling service is offered at no cost to individuals concerned with educational problems or degree objectives.

Classes cost \$30 per credit hour for all regular College of Lifelong Learning credit courses, except those offered through the weekend college program. Fee reductions are offered to students taking 13-16 credit hours. Persons 60 and older and those meeting certain criteria are eligible for reduced rates. All fees are subject to change.

Weekend courses are offered in social science, urban humanities, science, labor studies and other topics. Business classes include accounting, business administration, finance, management and marketing.

The College of Education courses include educational leadership, library science, teacher education, behavioral foundations, and several master's level programs.

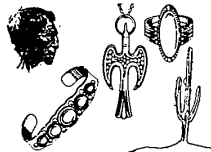
Courses are available in engineering, liberal arts, health and physical education, nursing and social work.

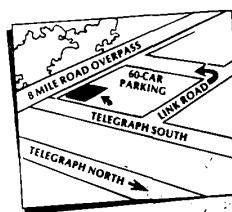

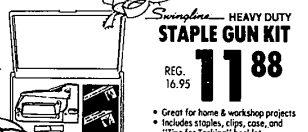
