Obituaries

VICTOR BASSO

Royal Joseph Basso, 68, of Detroit died Dec. 19 at Beaumont Hospital in Royal Oak following an unexpected illness.

Mr. Basso was born March 19, 1909 in Italy and had been a resident of the Detroit area for many years.

Since 1956, he has served as a trustee on the Lawrence Institute of Technology (LIT) board of directors. An architect, he specialized in institutional, hospital and religious buildings. His designs include Mercy Hospital in Port Huron.

Mr. Basso was the first student and graduate of LIT's department of engineering in 1934. He received an honorary doctorate in engineering from LIT

in 1968 and was a member of Phi Kappa Epsilon. He also was a member of the American Institute of Architects and the Michigan Society of Architects.

He is survived by sons Robert Victor Basso of Detroit, and Dr. Victor Jay Basso of Houston; grand-daughter Susie Basso at home and brothers Louis G. Basso and John J. Basso, both of Detroit.

Funeral services were Dec. 22 at William Sullivan and Sons in Royal Oak. A funeral mass was said at the Shrine of the Little Flower, also in Royal Oak. Burial was at Southfield's Holy Sepulchre Cemetery.

The family has requested that donations be made to the LIT School of Architecture.
