## Vets Get New Tax Exemptions

Comprehensive changes in
Michigan's veterane homestead
tax exemption program became
a reality July 19, when Governor George Romney signed a
linto law.

Prior to the new law, eligible weberane, widows and feer
principle weberane, widows and feer
to entitled to enexemption of \$2,000 on all taxsubje property not in excess of
\$10,000 state equalized.

With the enactment of the new
law, veterants' examption will
may be based upon an escalated
scale in ratio to percentage of
disability granted by the Veterane Administration. In addisability granted by the Veterane Administration, in addition, the new law provides
a minimum examption of \$2,500
on all taxable property not in
excess of \$10,000 state equaltized.

THE PROVISIONS of the new

THE PROVISIONS of the new law now include certain Viet-nam velerans and widows of Vietnam servicemen. These provisions of the law will not take effect until the beginning of the tax year December 31, 1988, The law provided an increase in basic exemption to 32,300 or all persons who were granted an exemption between the period December 31, 1989 and December 31, 1989,


## State Land Up For Sale
