Steel Firms To Lose All Defense Orders

WASHINGTON -- President Johnson announced that the steel problem is not settled and that there will probably be more action.

He has already ordered the Pentagon to cancel contracts with companies that have raised steel prices. After Bethlehem announced a price hike, National Steel, Jones and Laughlin and Armco and Crucible followed suit with price hikes.

AUSTIN, Tex. -- After telling reporters that "there will be additional action" in federal efforts to negate steel price hikes, Johnson left Washington for his Texas ranch.

He will "consider possible action" for the steel problem and wait out the Republican National Convention, May be the Democratic National Convention.

WASHINGTON -- Both Vice-President Hubert Humphrey and Senator Eugene McCarthy have called the starvation in Biafra deplorable and have called for U.S. involvement.

Humphrey said the U.S. should support any U.N. efforts to aid the starving Biafrans and McCarthy criticized American criticism of the situation.

NEW YORK -- The 13th bombing in Manhattan since April 22 broke out windows in the Bank of Tokyo on Park Avenue last week.

There were no injuries, although the force of the explosion shattered windows in the Trans World Airlines office across the street.

PHILADELPHIA -- In their 91st annual convention, the American Bar Association's Board of Governors resolved that present turmoil in American cities points out the urgency "for more adequate legal services for the poor."

More specifically, the resolution endorses the Kerner Commission's recommendations for legal action against slum housing conditions and exploitation of the ghettos, and the organization of neighborhood-action task forces.

ASTORIA, Ore. -- Dave Thomas, 25, "struck something big" in his Pacific fishing boat, and was forced overboard into his life raft. A woman ham radio operator relayed his only "distress call and he was picked up 40 hours later.

The Coast Guard had said the survival time for a soaking-wet man on a life raft in the Pacific was four hours.

DENVER -- Lt. Gen. Lewis B. Hershey, 75-year-old director of the Selective Service, announced that he has no plans for retiring.

The controversial director added: "I was appointed by Roosevelt, and I'm still here because nobody's fired me yet."

CLEVELAND -- Noting their reaction to the handling of the disturbance in Cleveland, the Fraternal Order of Police voted last week to call for the resignation of Safety Director Joseph F. McManamon.
