Until recently, most science-fiction films seemed to concentrate on technology or on extraterrestrial monsters
invading earth. In "Close Encounters of the Third Kind" (PG),
"Jaws" director Steven Spielberg sechews the dol cliches.
The subject of the movie is UFOs (unidentified flying
objects). Write-director Spielberg treats that subject in a way
which gives us the mystery of space without the menace of
monsters. It isn't as slick as "Star Wars" or as thoughful as
"Planet of the Apes." but it is oddly inspiring and optimistic.
The first two-thirds of the movie establish the occurrence
of strange phenomena throughout the world and display the
reaction of withnesses. The phenomena are sightings of UFOs
and odd manifestations associated with them.

Special effects invest these experiences with humor as
well as grander. Deterto-magnetic storms rage, brilliant
light illuminate the clarkest night, a fleet of spaceships vroom
