Section 1.
Article XVII, Section 1801, Notes to Schedule of Regulations, is hereby amended to add the following:

(1) Utility transformers or pedestals not exceeding four (4) feet in height may be placed within the minimum yard setbacks after a determination by the Director of Public Utilities that such placement is necessary to preserve and protect a valuable physical feature of the land and its foliage.
